A **Repeat Sign** tells you to go back to the beginning or previous repeat sign and play it again!

Slurs are used to make you play notes in different ways. Slurred notes are connected by a curved line. This piece uses a slur called a "pull off". Perform the slurs in this piece like this:

1. Pluck the first note. (Use a left hand finger to fret it first.)
2. Then do a "pull off" by pulling your left hand finger off the string towards the floor. It's like plucking the string with your left hand. This make the second note sound. Don't pluck the second note with your right hand. The second note connected by the slur ("E", 1st string open) is made to sound by the "pull off" action of your left hand.
